## Enrollment

In Physics, concurrent/extension-student enrollment starts in week 3, *after* UCSD-student enrollment has closed. To have your enrollment request considered you must submit your completed enrollment form and transcripts showing proof of completion of all listed pre-reqs to the Physics Advising Office (Mayer Hall Addition 2581) at/before the start of the term. If our office door is closed when you arrive, please slide your completed enrollment form and transcripts under our door. **The entire form must be completed except the instructor signature, which you do not need to obtain.** Please [click here](#) for assistance in completing your form.

Once we review your completed form and verify your pre-reqs we will add you to our extension student waitlist and hold your form until week 3. At the start of week 3 we will begin processing forms in the order received, pending available seating. If we are able to accommodate you, we will process your form and contact you via email with instructions for picking up your form. You must pick up your form and take it to [UCSD Extension](#) by Friday of week 3 to get enrolled. If we cannot accommodate you initially we will check for available seats up until Friday of week 3, when extension enrollment closes. If we are unable to accommodate you by the end of week 3 we will alert you via email.

Please Note:

- For verification purposes, transcripts must include the institution's printed name as well as the student's printed name. We do not waive pre-reqs for our courses.
- We will not hold/process incomplete forms.
- We cannot guess the chances that you will make it into a physics course, as that all depends on the number of drops after UCSD enrollment closes; there's no trend of week 3 drops by course/term.

## Attendance and Participation

You should attend and attempt to fully participate in our course starting on the first day of instruction, even though you are not formally enrolled. Please note that the instructor may ask that you exit the room if the room capacity has been reached by enrolled students. You are required to adhere to the direction of the instructor.

While waitlisted you are permitted to contact the course instructor to ask any questions you have about the content of the course, and to ask for copies of materials posted to [TritonEd](#) since you will not have access to it unless/until you are enrolled. You are also permitted to request that the instructor hold onto any quizzes/exams/assignments you take/submit in weeks 1 through 3, since your grades cannot be posted to TritonEd unless/until you are enrolled.
